



The contest was a success by the particiation of students from the department and also by the quality of the pictures students were able to capture.


World Day Against Child Labour


World Elder Abuse Awareness Day

Badira, the second semester MSW student handled the session in a professional way that the content she covered in her session was so crisp and clear to the fellow students.








IOTA, A bit of Knowledge – Lecture Series






The first session on Communicative English was conducted on 2nd July 2021. The following sessions were handled as per the students' and department convenience during the field work hours.

Sessions were planned in three days and three sessions. Common mistakes while communicating in English was the topic that was discussed in the first session. Surviving the mistakes and basic communication skills were handled in the second session and Body language was the focus area of the third session. Various exercises were given to the students. Students were also asked to self-evaluate on their language capabilities. The sessions were focusing more on the practical side of communication. Students shared their problems in handling the language in effective comunication and the several ways to manage them were also discussed. - To understand about the role of a social worker in child welfare settings.



The major objectives those were set for the session were,


- To study in details about family dynamics.

counsellor and also a previous faculty of Ideal College for Advanced studies handled the session for the students.







- 3. Family And Child Welfare






Students came online with their several cultural

MSW Offline Field Works-Nilambur & Attappadi - September

As a part of the MSW curriculum Students from second semester MSW students completed their Agency field work as two bathces in Nilambur and Attappadi.

The first batch of students completed their 22 days field work under the JSS (Jan shikshan sansthan) Malappuram. The field work started on 10 September 2021 and ended on 02 October 2021. As part of Tribal Development Fund (TDF) project of NABARD (National Bank of Agriculture and Rural Development), JSS conducted Baseline survey and Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) in Four Panchayath (Chaliyar, Moothedam, Karulai and Amarambalam Panchayath). The social work trainees participated in this project. The team members included Mr. Sreerag (DDUGKY and Yuvakeralam), Mr. Shakkeel (Placement officer), Mujeeb Rahman (NULM) and social work trainees from Ideal College for advanced studies Kadakassery and Sree Shankaracharya University of Sanskrit RC, Tirur. Before the PRA, JSS provided two days' workshop on PRA and Baseline survey.Mr. Mohanakrishan (Forest officer) was the resource person of the workshop. TDF is a project of NABARD in association with Jan Shikshan Sansthan, Malappuram. This is conducted in the tribal areas of Malappuram. The main aim of the project is to promote agriculture and livelihood in tribal areas. Moreover, ensure a permanent income to the people through this project.





The second batch completed their 20-day field work at KILA (Kerala Institute of local administration) institution. Trainees got an opportunity to work with the kudumbashree project, Attappady comprehensive tribal development program. The main objective of the field work was to enhance capabilities and apply Social Work skills and methods. Trainee's objectives were to get exposure from field work visit, by visiting NGOs, by attending orientation classes, by conducting case study and group work. The tribal development project aims to uplift the social and economic status of tribal communities through sustainable livelihood practices. The fieldwork commenced from 10th September 2021 and end at 30th September 2021.
