

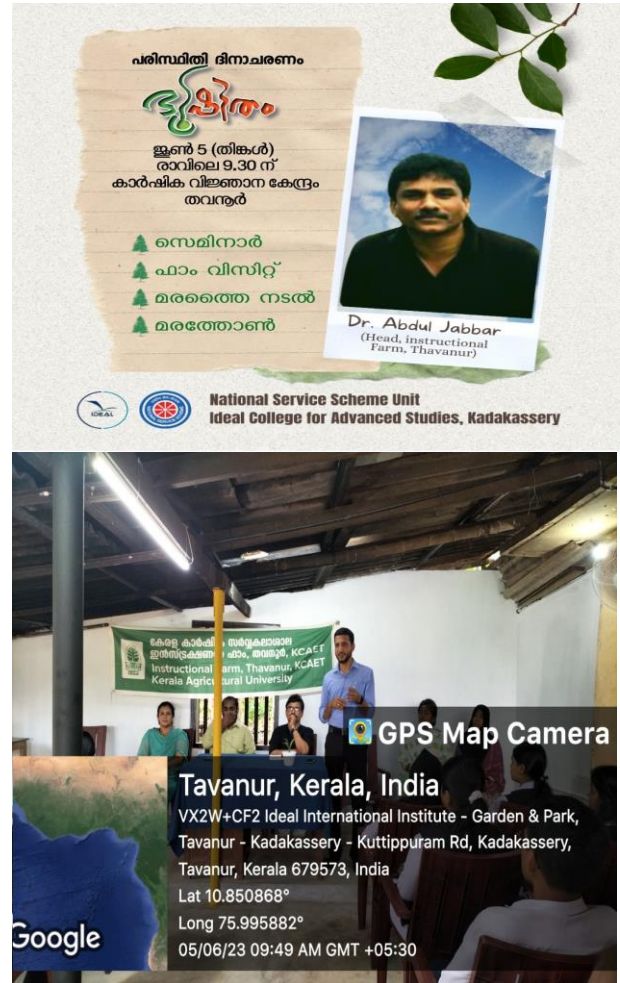

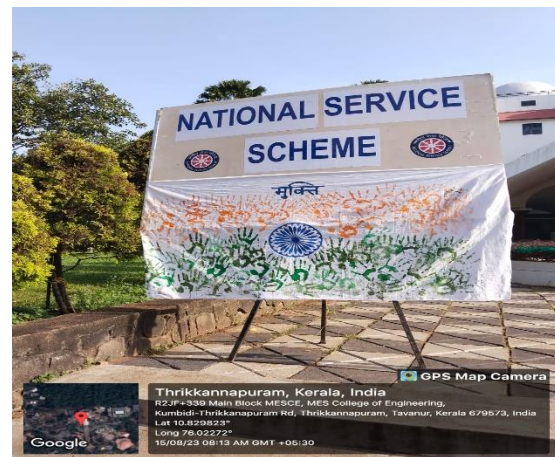
NSS EXHIBITION

After the common program the NSS volunteers and other students involved in program named 'Azadi ka Avaz' Administrative Officer Mr.Abhilash

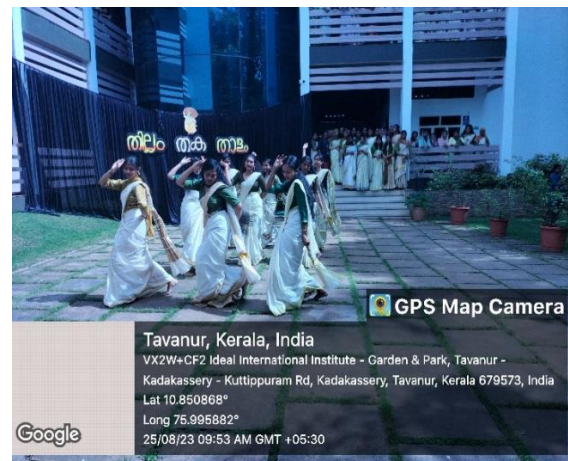
Sankar delivered a worthy inaugural speech in front of the gathering with this thoughtful words about the culture heritage of the nation followed by the

GANDHI JAYANTI

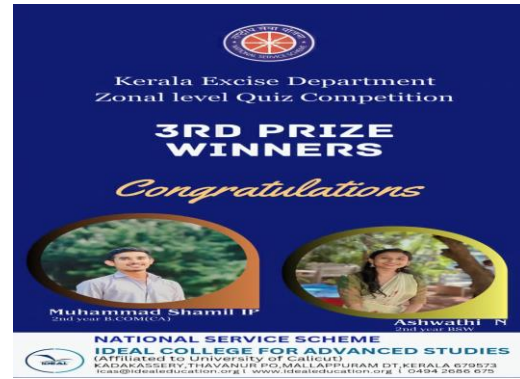
