



DETAILED REPORT ON BA ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE YEAR-WISE RESULT ANALYSIS

The BA English Language and Literature program has witnessed fluctuating academic outcomes over the years from 2017 to 2024. A detailed analysis of these results provides insights into the department's academic progress, the performance trends of its students, and areas where improvement may be necessary.

2017-2020 Batch (March 2020)

- **Appeared:** 24 students
- **Passed:** 18 students
- **Pass Percentage:** 75%

The 2017-2020 batch set a solid benchmark for the program with a pass rate of 75%. Out of the 24 students who appeared for the exams in March 2020, 18 successfully passed. This batch's performance reflected the department's strong academic foundation, with three-fourths of the students successfully completing the course. The 75% pass rate highlights the department's commitment to student support and quality education.

2018-2021 Batch (March 2021)

- **Appeared:** 30 students
- **Passed:** 19 students
- **Pass Percentage:** 61%

In March 2021, the 2018-2021 batch saw a noticeable dip in performance, with only 19 out of 30 students passing the exams, leading to a pass percentage of 61%. This decline could be attributed to various factors, including external disruptions, changes in instructional methods, or issues related to student engagement. The lower success rate signals the need for an assessment of academic challenges faced by this cohort, potentially including curriculum adjustments or enhanced support systems.

2019-2022 Batch (March 2022)

- **Appeared:** 33 students
- **Passed:** 29 students
- **Pass Percentage:** 88%

The 2019-2022 batch, however, marked a significant improvement. Out of the 33 students who appeared for the exams in March 2022, 29 passed, resulting in an impressive 88% pass rate. This cohort's success can be attributed to enhanced academic strategies, improved student engagement, and the department's adaptability in responding to challenges. The 88% pass rate underscores the department's ability to provide high-quality education and foster a strong learning environment.

2020-2023 Batch (March 2023)

- **Appeared:** 29 students
- **Passed:** 23 students
- **Pass Percentage:** 79%

The 2020-2023 batch maintained a strong pass percentage, with 23 out of 29 students successfully passing the exams in March 2023, achieving a pass rate of 79%. This result

reflects a balanced performance, demonstrating that the department has sustained its standards of excellence despite ongoing challenges. The 79% pass rate indicates consistent teaching quality and effective student support mechanisms.

2021-2024 Batch (March 2024)

- **Appeared:** 42 students
- **Passed:** 37 students
- **Pass Percentage:** 88%

The most recent batch, 2021-2024, achieved another excellent result, with 37 out of 42 students passing the exams in March 2024, yielding a pass rate of 88%. This high percentage mirrors the strong performance of the 2019-2022 batch and highlights the department's ability to sustain academic success over time. The fact that 88% of the students passed is a testament to the department's effective instructional methods and the students' dedication.
